



PROTECTIVE PADDING RECOMMENDED CARE AND CLEANING

All end users of vinyl laminates should follow a regular cleaning schedule.

There is a reaction that takes place between the laminate surface and the airborne pollutants that land on this surface. Therefore, it is important that these pollutants be removed on a regular basis. The laminate should be washed as needed, typically, three times per year. This should be based on local climate and pollution levels. However, the laminate should be hosed more regularly; a monthly maintenance regimen is suggested.

CLEANING

- Keep the laminate clean. This is the best protection against mildew. Mildew can grow on accumulated dirt and foreign materials.
- Cleaning vinyl laminates involves using a proven cleaning product sold by Promats or mild, high-sudsing soap and water.
- Do not use any cleaning products that contain chlorine since these products, if left on the vinyl can cause discoloration, as well as, deterioration.
- Use a soft-bristle brush on stubborn stains if necessary. Hand washing is best.
- Never use pressure washers on the laminate, this can destroy the surface of the laminate.
- Thoroughly rinse the laminate to remove any trace of cleaning material including soap.
- Hose the laminate with clean water occasionally, every month or so. We recommend that you do this on a hot, sunny day.

GENERAL CARE

- For additional protection, apply a protector sold by Promats. Protectors should be applied after every washing.
- Apply protectors to clean laminates only. Do not apply protectors between washes, as this will trap any dirt and pollutants between layers of protection that can cause mildew and discoloration.
- If the laminate is used where liquid fertilizers, insecticides, or similar products are used, cover the laminate to reduce the possibility of overspray landing, and remaining on the vinyl.
- If the laminate is to be stored, be certain it is thoroughly dried before being folded, rolled, and bagged.
- Stored in an area where there is little chance of the item getting wet, frozen, or overheated.

VINYL KLEEN PLUS: A concentrated vinyl cleaner and deoxidizer which removes streaking, chalking and oxidation from vinyl. This product is designed for general maintenance use. Available in 5-gallon and 1-gallon containers. Rinse thoroughly. **DO NOT** use in extremely hot weather, where cleaner will dry before rinsing or streaking may occur. Coverage: 2,000 square feet per gallon.

VINYL PROTECTOR: A dressing that helps to restore vitality to vinyl that has been damaged by plasticizer migration. This is the ultimate in vinyl protection. Available in 5-gallon and 1-gallon containers. **DO NOT** rinse after sealer application. Sealing should take place after graphic installation. Coverage: 2,000 square feet per gallon.
